TWO MAN DORY SPECIFICATIONS

1. Length: not to exceed 20 feet 6 inches
2. Length bottom: not to exceed 16 feet 6 inches, including any rocker.
3. Beam: not to exceed 72 inches at gunwale.
4. Width: not to be less than 35 inches at the widest outside bottom measurement across the chimes.
5. Gunwale Height: (freeboard) not to be less than 26 inches at any point between chime and gunwale.
6. The “crown” of dory bottom will be allowed a tolerance of plus or minus one inch.
7. The minimum weight, including thwarts and row locks, shall not be less than 300 pounds.
8. The span between row lock centers at the oar well centers will be determined by the individual.
9. Construction material is to be left to the builder’s preference.
10. Non-binding foot straps will be permitted, however, sliding seats will not be allowed.
11. Oars can be of any construction and may be individually shaped or formed as desired.
12. Boat markings: lettering and numbers on boats are required. Letters and numbers must be placed on the bow of a boat in block style and of a contrasting color. Minimum sizes — 16 inches high, 12 inches wide, 3 inches in thickness.
13. Dories in competition since 1960 not meeting these standards will be allowed to continue racing as long as they meet minimum weight.
